

HEALING SEEDS

Proverbs 4:20-21 "My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart."

How do we Attend to the Word of God?

1. Incline thine ear:

- a. Listen carefully to God's Word
- b. Not to Doctors, family, friends & circumstances

2. Let them not depart from thine eyes:

- a. Find the Promises of God!
- b. Your eyes need to be kept focused on God's testimonies in the Word!
- c. Don't focus on your symptoms or your circumstances!
- d. Romans chapter 4 - Abraham became "strong in faith" as he looked at God and not at his or Sarah's body.

3. Keep them in the midst of thine heart:

- a. Meditate on the promises of God concerning the harvest you need and anticipate a harvest!
- b. Farmers don't plant seed and then go out each day and dig them up to see how they are doing. They plant and anticipate a harvest having faith in nature.

Proverbs 4:22 For they are life unto those that find them and health to all their flesh."

Let's learn something from nature:

Farmers don't buy seeds and leave them in the barn. They plant them.

Mark 4:26-29 "And he said, so is the kingdom of God; it's as if a man should plant seeds in the ground and should go to be and rise up each day. The seeds springs froth and grows; he does not know how for the earth brings forth the fruit on its own; first the blade, then the ear and then the full corn in the ear. But, when the fruit comes, immediately he puts in the sickle because it's harvest time!"

But after the farmer plants the seeds he doesn't go out each day and dig them up to see how they are doing!

No! He understands the “Laws of Nature” and he plants his seeds in anticipation of a Harvest.

When we understand the Laws of God we can also anticipate a Harvest of Healing!

This is no “Jack and Beanstalk” Bible!

The farmer is not looking for the full corn in the ear right away.

He is not discouraged when all he sees is the “blade”.

When he sees the blade he rejoices that the process has begun!

When you plant “healing seeds” you can expect a harvest of healing to come in due season!

God’s Word will bring about the Healing!

What about seeds of doubt?

What about the “Seeds of Doubt”

When your ears and eyes are on symptoms and circumstances more than on God’s Word... You have planted “Seeds of Doubt”...

And you shall “reap what you sow”!

You can get rid of the seeds of doubt that the devil hands out by looking only at God’s Word and it’s testimony of Healing.

Hebrews 12:2 Keep looking unto Jesus and the Word!

Keep the Healing Seeds in good ground!

Hebrews 6:11-12 “And we desire that every one of you do show the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end: that ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.”

Hebrews 10:35 - 36 Therefore do not cast away your confidence, which has great reward. For you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise.”

Wait Patiently!

Once you have planted the seeds of healing into the good ground of your heart you can pray with faith believing that you will have what you ask for.

You must not lose heart if you don't see a harvest immediately.

Not receiving a miracle does not mean you will not harvest a healing.

Weed Your Garden!

Have faith and patience, for if you have them you can have the full assurance that you will inherit the promise...

You will reap a harvest of healing!
